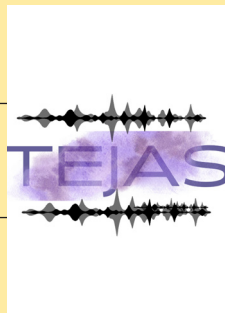

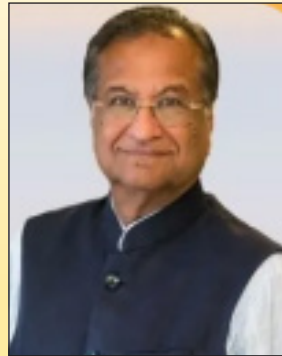

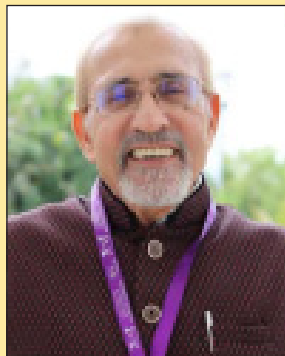

# Did you know that the Vande Mataram movement originated in our city?

**T**he Vand Mataram movement originated in Aurangabad, then part of the Hyderabad state, and stands out as a crucial chapter in India's struggle for independence. The ban on singing Vande Mataram sparked a united resistance, transcending societal labels and inspiring a collective struggle for civil and political rights.

The movement originated when students in Aurangabad protested the ban on singing Vande Mataram in the Government Intermediate College hostel on November 16, 1938. The charismatic influence of Swami RamanandTirth, founder of Hyderabad state Congress, played a pivotal role in awakening the spirit of resistance against autocratic rule.

Encouraged by G.M. Shroff, students at Government Intermediate College in Aurangabad stood firm against the ban on singing VandeMataram, underscoring their commitment to nationalistic ideals.

The Vande Mataram movement in Aurangabad serves as a testament to the unwavering spirit of the youth. This laid the foundation for future leaders, shaping India's path towards independence. Understanding the roots of this movement is crucial to acknowledging the sacrifices made by those who played a pivotal role in shaping India's journey to freedom.

# Startups: The fuel for BHARAT's GROWTH

**S**tartup India is a flagship initiative of the Government of India, intended to catalyse startup culture and build a strong and inclusive ecosystem for innovation and entrepreneurship in India. From 340+ startups in 2016 to 1,15,000+ startups in 2023 – the Startup India initiative has played a pivotal role in shaping the startup ecosystem in India. Multiple initiatives like the Seed Fund Scheme, Fund of Funds Scheme, Credit Guarantee Scheme for Startups, MAARG mentorship platform, National Startup Awards, State Ranking Framework are some of the key pillars driving the spirit of entrepreneurship.

Launched on 16th January, 2016, the Startup India Initiative has rolled out several programs with the objective of supporting entrepreneurs, building a robust startup ecosystem and transforming India into a country of job creators instead of job seekers. These programs are managed by a dedicated Startup India Team, which reports to the Department for Industrial Policy and Promotion (DPIIT).

**Startup Funding:**

Funding refers to the money required to start and run a business. It is a financial investment in a company for product development, manufacturing, expansion, sales and marketing, office spaces, and inventory. Many startups choose to not raise funding from third parties and are funded by their founders only (to prevent debts and equity dilution). However, most startups do raise funding, especially as they grow larger and scale their operations.

These smarter devices are here to stay in 2024 and even further, as data scientists are working on AI home robots, appliances, work devices, wearables, and so much more! Almost every job needs smart software applications to make our work life more manageable. ### 3) Virtual Reality (VR) and Augmented Reality (AR),

These technologies hold immense potential in areas such as training, entertainment, education, marketing, and rehabilitation. From training surgeons to providing enhanced museum experiences and improving marketing campaigns, VR and AR are versatile tools. For individuals interested in these fields, entry doesn't necessarily demand specialized optics skills; basic programming abilities and a forward-thinking mindset can open doors to employment opportunities. This technology trend deserves attention on your radar!

### 4) 5-G

The subsequent technological advancement following the AR and VR is 5G. While 3G and 4G technologies facilitated internet browsing, data-driven services, increased bandwidth for streaming on platforms like Spotify or YouTube, and more, the anticipated impact of 5G services is revolutionary.

### 5) Cyber Security

Cyber security might not seem like an emerging new technology trend, given that it has been around for a while, but it is evolving just as other technologies are. That's in part because threats are constantly new. The malevolent hackers trying to access data illegally will not give up any time soon, and they will continue to find ways to get through even the toughest security measures. It's also partly because new technology is being adapted to enhance security. As long as we have hackers, cybersecurity will remain a trending technology because it will constantly evolve to defend against those hackers.

According to Gartner, by 2025, 60% of organizations will use cybersecurity risk as a primary determinant in conducting third-party transactions and business engagements.

### 6) Metaverse

The metaverse is a virtual, interconnected digital realm where users engage with one another and digital environments in real-time.
